SAFE

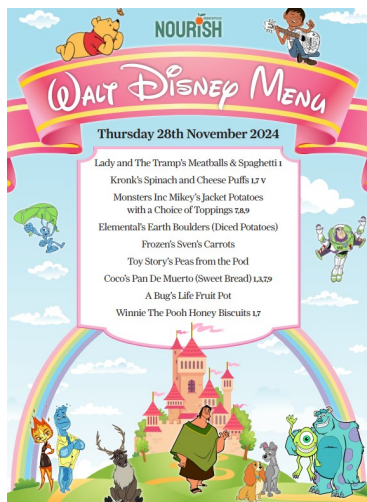
