What can you do to help?

Make sure you are reading at least 3 times a week. Make sure that you ask questions, encourage fluency and encourage reading with expression.

Also spellings, number bonds and any learning about la range of jobs would be great. .

As healthy people we will:

- Be learning about people in our community that help us.
- Consider the ways in which people stay safe in their jobs.
- Think about the jobs we might like to do in the future.

As historians we will:

- Learn about the history of television.
- Compare the past to the present.
- Examine the original purpose of the soap opera.
- Consider reasons why jobs and technology change over time.

As geographers we will:

- Explore the services and buildings in the local area.
- Create our own street map.
- Use a map to find out information.

As artists we will:

- Understand the key features of a portrait.
- Be creating a self-portrait using a range of materials.

As designers we will:

- Use a range of materials to make vehicles for our street map.
- Examine the importance of uniform in a profession and designing our own.
- Be creating an ID card for our future selves in 20 years' time.

- In RE we will be looking at what makes places sacred for Christians, Jews and Muslims.
- In PE we will be doing gymnastics and multi sports.
- In PSHE we will be looking at 'healthy and safe lifestyles – managing risks'
