SAFE On Monday, Marina and Sue from Sidcup Leisure Centre visited us to talk to the children about water safety as part of Drowning Prevention Week. The children learned important messages about staying safe around water and what to do if they ever find themselves in difficulty.



A letter was sent home this week reminding families about our Administering Medication policy. Please remember that school staff can only administer prescribed medication when the appropriate consent form has been completed. We are unable to administer non-prescribed medicines, including Calpol and ibuprofen. Please also note that many prescribed medications, including antibiotics prescribed three times a day, can usually be administered before school, after school and at bedtime, meaning they do not need to be brought into school. Thank you for your support in helping us keep all children safe and ensuring that medication is administered appropriately.
